Please read section **43A(1)&(2) of the Arms Act 1983** for laws relating to mail order or Internet sales of arms items or ammunition.

New Zealand has a new Firearms Registry. If you're a firearms licence holder, you have until 24 June 2028 to register your firearms. However, there are activating circumstances when you're required to provide information to the Registry within a shorter time frame. To find out how and when to register your firearms, go to firearmssafetyauthority.govt.nz/registry.

1. This form is used to apply for approval of the sale and purchase of non prohibited arms items and ammunition by mail order or on the Internet.
2. You may not take possession of any non-prohibited firearm, non-prohibited magazine, non-prohibited part, ammunition and/or pistol carbine conversion kit unless you have a current firearms or dealer licence.
3. If you are purchasing an airgun, you need to be 18 years of age or older if you do not have a firearms licence.
